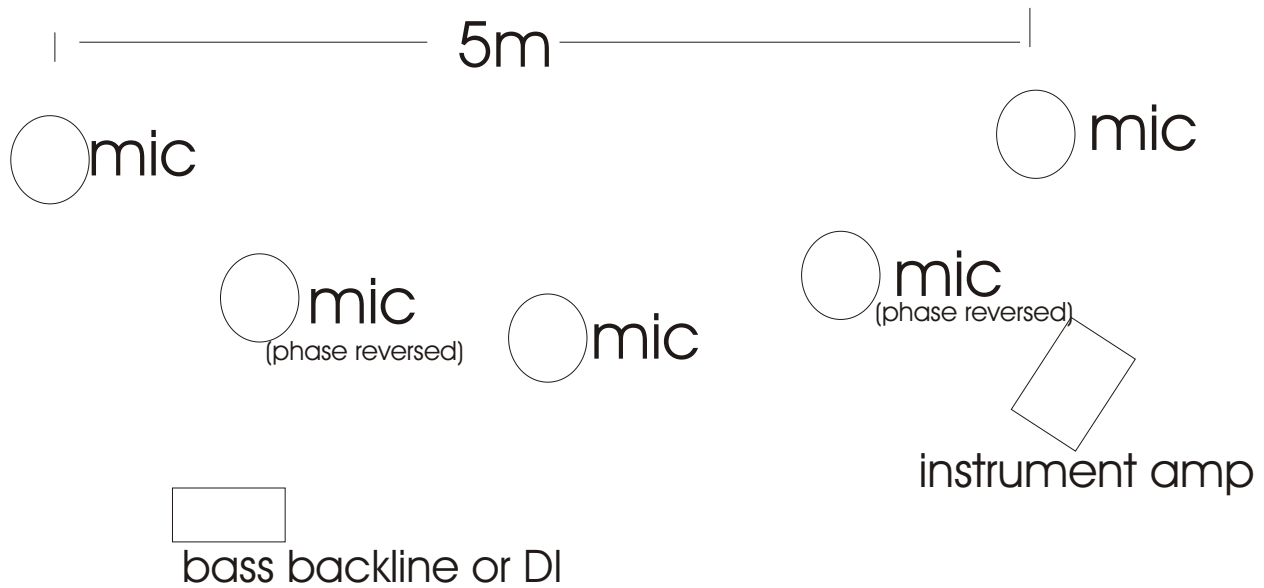


WISE FAMILY BAND STAGE PLAN

○ Mics

We use one mic each for vocals AND instruments, sometimes simultaneously and always at a greater distance (30cm - 1m) than vocal mics are generally used. Normal dynamic vocal mics sound very thin if used this way. Condensers, such as the EV 510 or Co11 work much better for us as the bass response is much better. We carry some with us. If your system is "tuned" to 58s and you want us to use them, please boost the low end on the channel. We also commonly run mics 2 and 4 out of phase with the others. This keeps the sound a lot cleaner.

□ D.I.s

Any D.I. or bass rig is fine for us. We carry our own D.I.s or acoustic amp for guitar. We like to have mic signal on the guitars out front with whatever you need to add from the D.I.

FOLDBACK Since we mostly use an instrument amp onstage, we can work without foldback in most situations. As we are depending on mics for our F.O.H sound this enables more gain from the mics as well.

ONSTAGE AMPS

We use an AER 4 channel acoustic amp for our own onstage instrument monitoring, for guitars only. It has a DI output and numerous other options. We rarely use more than one channel at a time, so the DI output can be used in front of house as well to fill out the bottom end. We usually carry a small bass amp as well.
